

Louisiana Behavioral Health Crisis Services

If you are having emotional distress due to problems with your mental health or substance use and need help right away, Aetna Better Health of Louisiana offers these crisis services for adults ages 21 and older:



Mobile Crisis Response

- A behavioral health crisis team who meets you at your home or wherever you are in the community



Behavioral Health Crisis Care

- A behavioral health crisis walk-in center with a home-like environment



Community Brief Crisis Support

- Ongoing follow up care available for up to 15 days after receiving Mobile Crisis Response or Behavioral Health Crisis Care

Note: If you already receive Community Psychiatric Support and Treatment (CPST), Psychosocial Rehabilitation (PSR), or Assertive Community Treatment (ACT), please follow your provider's crisis care plan.
